Carmel College, Milford: Mackenzie O'Neill won gold in the Junior Girls Hammer Event at the New Zealand Secondary Schools Athletics Championships.

Rosmini College, Auckland: Richard Rahardja competed at the ninth WKF Junior World Karate Championships in Indonesia where he won a bronze medal in the 16/17 year Male Kata division, he is now only the third New Zealander ever to win a world medal.

Campion College, Gisborne: Jack Virtue helped in a rescue of four people caught in a rip at Wainui Beach, all four were safely brought back to shore. Steven Doherty won gold in the 500m Intermediate Mens at the Activepost Waka Ama Sprint Nationals. Kai Woolf was first in the U14 New Zealand Scholastics Surfing Competition. Edan Wilson won gold at the NZ Surf Lifesaving U12 Grand Cameron Relay. Aoife Fyall won gold in the Line Throw Relay, breaking a New Zealand record at the NZ Surf Lifesaving Pool Champs. At the same event Nathan Proctor won a gold in the 50m with fins (breaking another record) and won gold in the brick carry and the U12 Grand Cameron Relay.

Sacred Heart Girls' College, New Plymouth: Olivia Eiffe won a gold medal for her Beam routine at the New Zealand Gymnastics Nationals. Hannah O'Connor won both the 1500m and the 3000m at the New Zealand Secondary Schools Track and Field Nationals.

Sacred Heart Girls' College, Napier: Alexandra Thompson was awarded the Best Novice/New Pilot trophy in 2015, she currently holds the record for the youngest glider pilot in New Zealand and the United Kingdom and has qualified to fly any glider or single seaters on her own.

St Mary's College, Wellington: Rosie Walsh was selected for the New Zealand Woman's Gymnastics Team National Team and competed in Hawaii in January.

Bishop Viard College, Porirua: Brandy Collins won a gold medal in both the Discus and the Shot Put in the Senior Girls division at the New Zealand Secondary Schools Athletics Championships.
